Please check your monitor calibration before viewing any of our gallery images.

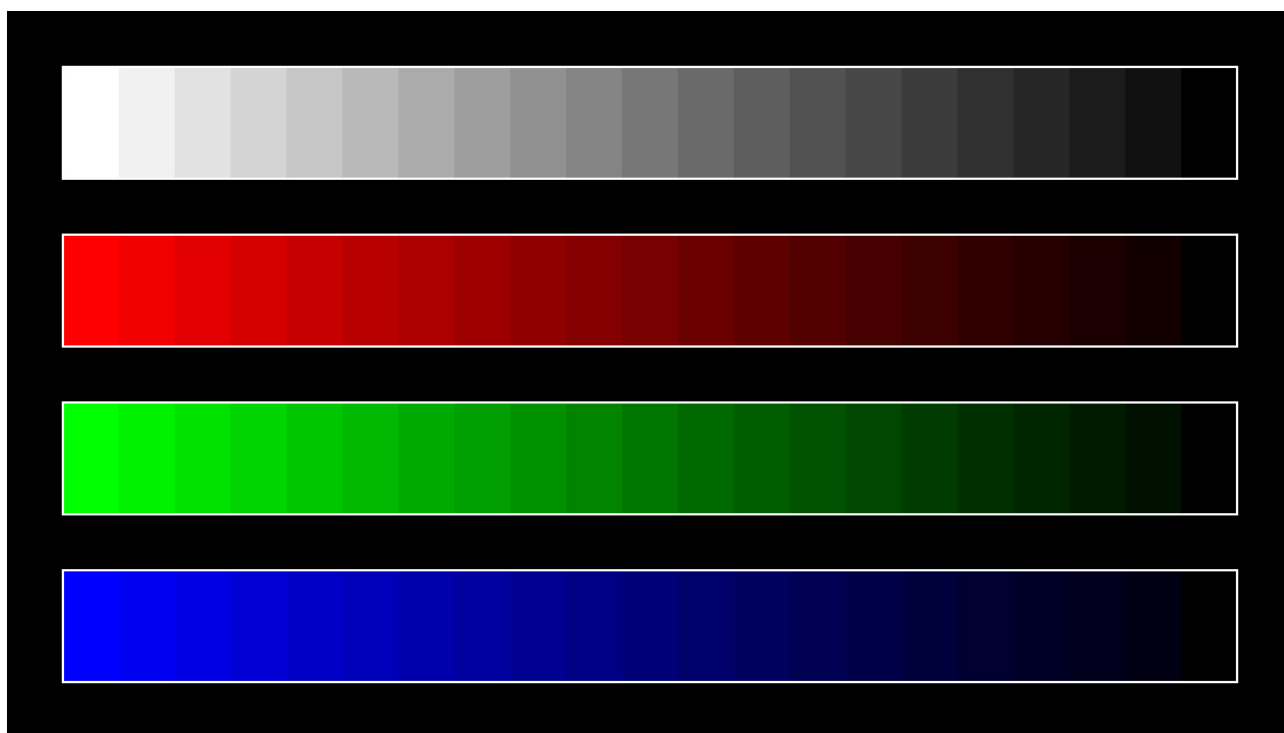


Quick Calibration

If your monitor has not been calibrated, then Ian Lyons of the [Computer-Darkroom site](http://www.computer-darkroom.com) suggests...

Use the grey wedge below to adjust your monitor's brightness and contrast controls so that at least the first 12 steps e.g. from white to 95% black are distinctly visible, the distinction between 95% and 100% should just be barely visible.

First set your monitor contrast control to maximum, then adjust the brightness.
