

# PSthis2021

Deadline for entries: **16 July 2021** (PDI night)  
Judging: **23 July 2021** (voting by club members)

## Minimum requirements:

Your image must include the following elements:

1. Location - **A sandy beach**
2. Character – **An adult male or female (to be positioned on the sandy beach)**
3. Object – **A beach-themed object or accessory (eg. a vehicle, surfboard, boat or even a bucket and spade, etc.)**

## Further information:

- You may include as many other elements as you wish as long as you have the 3 key objects listed above.
- The competition is PDI only (projected digital image, jpg, maximum 1920x1200px).
- All of the elements in your composite must have been taken through a lens of a camera and be your own work. i.e. no CGI (computer-generated imagery)
- However, please note that you retain the copyright to your image & it can therefore be entered into any upcoming competition as either a print or PDI, for example:

June Print (2<sup>nd</sup> leg of ARC print competition)  
August PDI (set subject: Creative)  
August Print (set subject: Creative)  
September Print (3<sup>rd</sup> leg of ARC print competition)

- This is a non-graded competition with a certificate presented to the winner at the annual dinner.
- It is intended to be a fun project and encourage you to explore creative techniques, such as filters and layers in Photoshop.
- It is not compulsory to use Photoshop. You may take a photo with all 3 elements in-camera. Humour is encouraged.
- Time will be set aside to go through basic compositing techniques. If you need help please ask and / or bring your PSD file with you and we might use your file for training on print judging night on **June 11**.
- Bring your PSD file to the judging night on July 23. If you are the first or second place getter we would love to hear you talk a little bit on the night about how you made your image.
- If time permits, anyone else who would like to talk about the making of their image will be encouraged to do so.
- Remember, this activity is all about having fun, learning something, and sharing our enthusiasm for our art.
