Reports From The PDI Coordinator October 2022

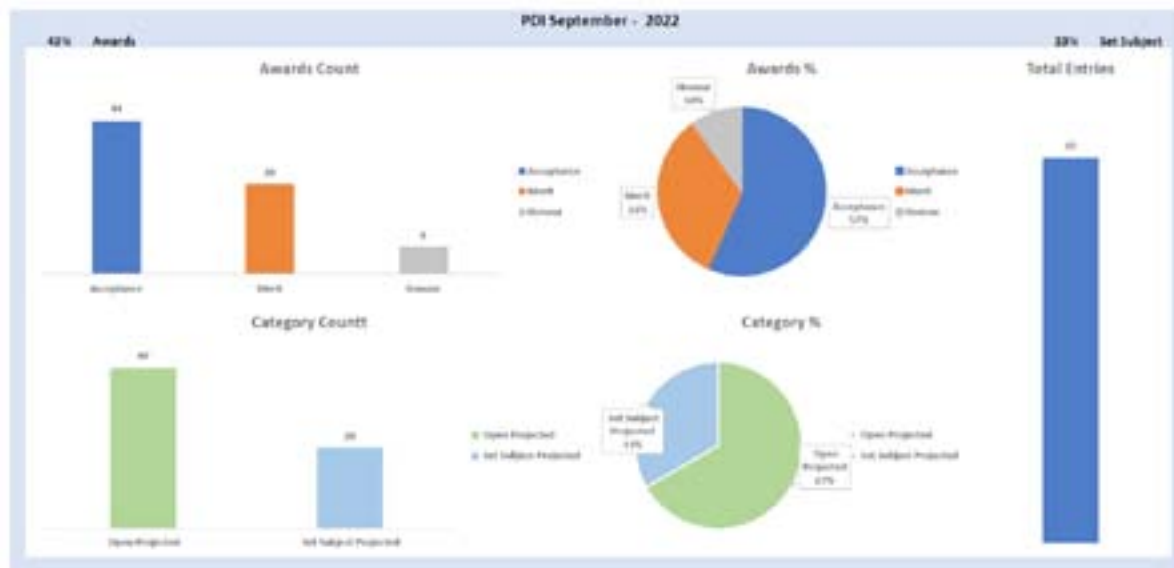
September PDI Comp

General items

- Multiple entry of an image –
 - PCC rules dictate that an image entered into competition that received an "Entry" or "Acceptance" may be used a second time in any category. Once the image has been used a second time it cannot be used again, regardless of the award given.
 - If an entry received a "Merit" or "Honour" it cannot be used again.
 - The PDI -Coordinator contacted a member to inform them that they entered an image multiple times and was in breach of the rules, he requested that the entry be replaced before closing of the competition. The member declined to replace the image and the image was thus disqualified from the October PDI competition
